

# Piner High School

## Scholarship

The Piner High School (PHS) PTSA offers graduating high school Senior scholarships to acknowledge the achievements of high school seniors for volunteer service in the school and community.

### AVAILABILITY

Scholarship funds are available to high school seniors graduating from Piner High School at the end of the current academic year. Scholarship is to be used for expenses related to attendance at an accredited college or university, community college or trade/technical school following high school graduation.

### APPLICATION AND DUE DATE

An application may be obtained from the Piner High School office. Completed application, copies of required documentation and references are to be submitted in one envelope to the Piner High School PTSA. Application must be received in the Piner High School office by the close of business March 1st. When March 1st falls on a weekend, holiday or scheduled school closure, the application will be due the end of the following business day. Application will not be considered if received after the due date or if any of the required materials are missing. Original application and reference forms must be received in their original form. Facsimiles will not be accepted.

### QUALIFICATIONS

- Applicant must be a California resident graduating from Piner High School.
- Applicant must be an active member of PHS PTSA by December of Senior year. Active status is defined as a paid member plus participation, which can be in the form of attending meetings and/or participating in events. A copy of a current PHS PTSA membership card (or written confirmation of membership by the PHS PTSA President) is required.
- Applicant must maintain a minimum 2.5 grade point average (GPA) during high school and their first semester in college. A copy of the student's last available transcript is required.
- Applicant must complete a full load, defined as 12 units, during their first semester, post high school graduation. A copy of the student's post-secondary transcript will be required as proof of completion.

### SELECTION

Recipients are selected by members of the Piner High School PTSA Scholarship Committee. The Piner High School PTSA Scholarship is awarded at Piner High School's Awards Night. Scholarship is paid directly to the recipient by check after successful completion of the first semester of post-secondary education. If there are more applicants than there are scholarships, the Piner High School PTSA Scholarship Committee will determine the recipient based on the above criteria.
